What we do

Conduct Training Courses in Specific Methods for Teaching Dyslexics.

Refer children and adult dyslexics for screening and specialist tutoring.

The Bursary Fund Committee raises funds to help finance lessons for students whose parents would find it difficult to manage these individualized lessons.

The Association also has a register of Educational Psychologists for referral for assessments.

Conduct Public awareness sessions on Dyslexia and related learning difficulties.
